- Maintain safe and healthy working conditions, having put in place measures to reduce accidents and the risk of cases of work-related ill-health;

- Consult with our employees on matters affecting their health and safety;
- Provide and maintain safe equipment, and ensure the safe handling and use of substances and equipment;

- Ensure that all contractors and sub-contractors are aware of our safety procedures and systems and take reasonable steps to ensure that they comply with them;
- Review and revise the health and safety policies and systems as appropriate in line with good practice; and
- Carry out regular reviews of the health and safety management systems to ensure continuous improvement.
