Hosted in Madrid, as part of ICCA Congress 2026, the programme features opening remarks from regional authorities and international representatives, followed by two in-depth round tables. The first focuses on the role of the Arbitration Council of the Community of Madrid in promoting domestic arbitration, while the second examines dispute prevention and mitigation in real estate, energy, and infrastructure projects from a global perspective.
